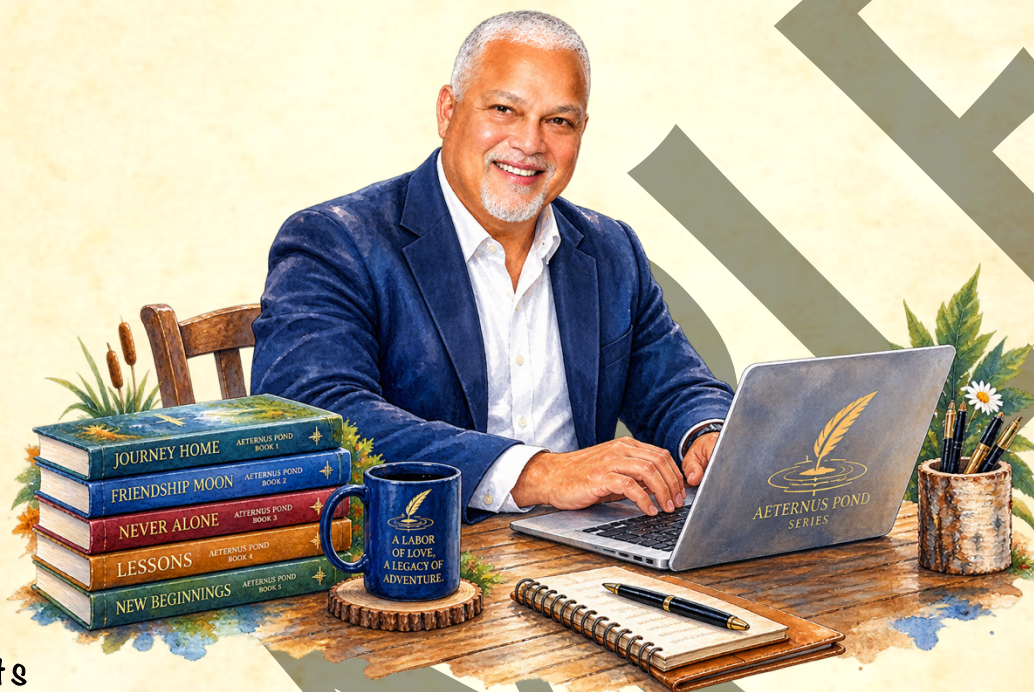
Nature Observation
